

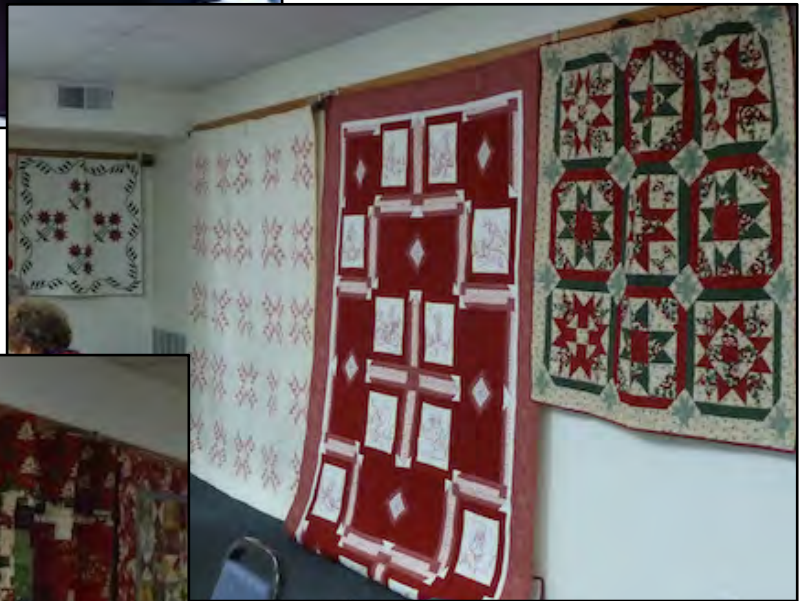

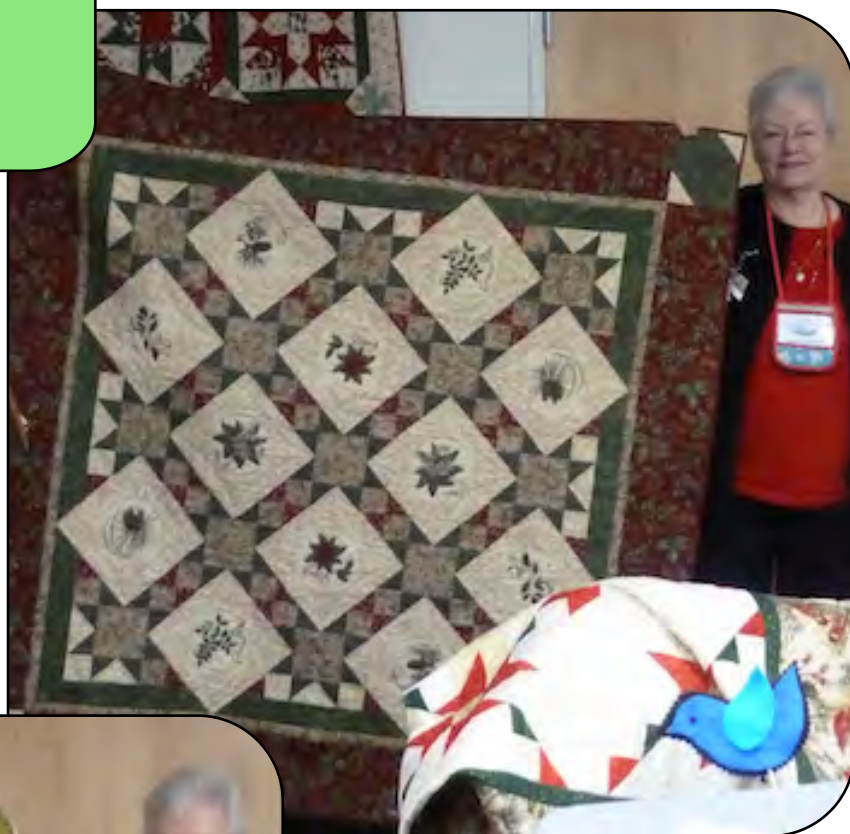
MORE DECEMBER MEETING PHOTOS
