MEMBERSHIP UPDATE




QUILT CHALLENGE 2018 – “IT’S ELEMENTAL”

Earth – Wind – Fire – Water. All OCQG are challenged to make a quilt embodying the concept of one or more of the medieval basic elements – earth, wind, fire, and water. See the poster at our meetings for some examples of how people have visually interpreted “earth, wind, fire, and water.”

1. The quilt must embody one or more of the above elements.
2. Quilts must be no more than 30” in any dimension, with a total outside circumference of no more than 120”. Quilts may be smaller if desired.
3. Embellishments are welcome but not required.
4. All quilts must be made entirely by the entrant.
5. A 3” x 5” card with the name of the quilt must be safety-pinned to the lower front right corner. The quilt-maker’s name must be on the back of the quilt, covered with a piece of paper.
6. Quilts must be brought to the June meeting in a brown paper bag and will be voted on at the June and July meetings.


