Latimer Weavers Exhibit

The Latimer Weavers practice their craft both at Latimer and on their home looms. They produce a wide variety of products from an equally varied amount of fibers. They may use silk, wool, cotton, synthetics or combinations of the above.

They learn from each other, since the passing of long time Master Teacher, Shirley Medsker. One wall of the exhibit room is dedicated to examples of Shirley's work.

For this Weavers' Gallery Show the Weavers will have a community loom so visitors can try their hand at floor loom weaving. Indeed, the loom is currently available for visitors in the weaving room. The loom is warped in the spirit of the Japanese Saori tradition with plain weave and two treadle pattern. This encourages free expression with yarn as an antidote to mass-production and mass consumption. "Mistakes" are design elements. It does not matter if your selvages are straight or your beat is irregular. Your cloth is made by human hand, not machine. Come enjoy weaving with us.




