**2025 Challenge Quilt – Darcy/Joy - "Trips and Travels**", like usual can be no larger than 120" in circumference (example 30" on each side for a square). 4" hanging sleeve. Must contain 1 button (either with holes to sew

on or a shank on the back type) must be able to be sewn on the front of the Quilt somewhere but if needed can be glued on. Then finally needs an embellishment. In addition, a ½ page sheet with the story typed telling the quilt's story will be required. June 1 pictures are due.
