2025 Challenge Quilt – Darcy/Joy - “*Trips and Travels*”, like usual can be no larger than 120” in circumference (example 30” on each side for a square). 4” hanging sleeve. Must contain 1 button (either with holes to sew on or a shank on the back type) must be able to be sewn on the front of the Quilt somewhere but if needed can be glued on. Then finally needs an embellishment. In addition, a ½ page sheet with the story typed telling the quilt’s story will be required. **Picture of your challenge quilt is DUE June 1 to Nan Scott.**

Community Quilters – Lindanne/Lynn– Lynn spoke about burb cloth kits and receiving blankets. She was also ready to deliver burb cloths, receiving blankets and knitted baby caps to the hospital today or soon. Lindanne spoke on Walker caddies as a new project for community quilt group which Jan McQueen proposed the idea and pattern. Those kits will be available in the future. Kits today on the table are burp cloths, pillowcases, receiving blankets, also a few blankets need binding sewn on available at the table for folks to take home and work on to bring back next meeting.
