Announcements:

Presentation of a check to Lincoln County Food Share from the 2025 Silent Auction. Want to thank all the quilters that donated to the auction. The director was there to accept check and thanked the guild as the Food Share has seen a notable uptick in demand from the county.

Barbara spoke on nominations. Her job this year is going to be rather easy as all officers agreed to stay on another year.

Committee Reports

Challenge Quilts: Darcy de la Rosa. – Semi-quincentennial – America Beautiful (National Park or Monument or Scenic Wonder) 102" in circumference. Must have a flag on it. Due by July 1, 2026.

Community Quilters – Nancy H.– To date this year we have delivered 215 quilts – with 89 to Community Services (Head Start Newport), 29 Siletz Head Start, 14 to VA home in Lebanon (which houses Lincoln County Vets), 15 to Siletz Tribe foster kids' program, 45 (approx.) Baby Quilts to

SPCH, 22 Baby Quilts (SNLH), 1 adult quilt to SNLH. Additional items: 103 burp cloths, 46 walker bags, 43 receiving blankets, 4 knitted caps, 3 fleece blankets, 30 small pillows, 25 larger pillows for literacy center, 17 dog beds to support humane society. Going to start making chemo bags which are needed for patients at the hospital.
