Community Quilters – Nancy Hoover – April donations are as follows:
2 Quilts to Samaritan House, 4 Pillows to Seashore Literacy, 10 Pillows to SCPH infusion center, 7 Adult bibs to Veteran’s Home. SPCH Labor & Delivery: 39 quilts, 30 receiving blankets, 9 burp clothes, 1 knitted cap.

It should be noted that SCPH is averaging between 25-30 babies a month.
