- ☐ Alternate Gridwork – Breaking the predictable pattern in the quilt

- ☐ Colors – bold saturated colors, on-trend combinations, Use of Solid Fabrics, Low volume Fabrics

- ☐ Minimalistic/Maximalism –

 - o Minimalism - Less is more. Limited color pallet, big open spaces with filled in quilting in open spaces

 - o Maximalist – Lots and lots of colors, no empty space,

- ☐ Improvisation – emphasizes the process of creation as the final product. Color, shape and mood.
