2026 Challenge Quilts: Darcy de la Rosa. – Voting begins tomorrow and of the 25 that signed up we received 8 great quilts to be judged and voted on.

Community Quilters – Nancy Hoover – We now have 70 quilts set aside for the Head Start programs and I thank everyone who has contributed. Most of us have done a few quilts for charity but would like to recognize a few people who contributed heavily to make it possible to give so many to

Head Start. I would like to mention a few by my list maybe a bit incomplete.

- Diane Merys has quilted over 30 quilts, partly in memorial to Barb Martin who started us working with Head Start.
- Lincoln City Quilters who have completed 11 quilts for guild projects in addition to 12 quilts and fleece blankets to support the Siletz Foster Kids and who continue to support guild projects.
