

Class for the Half log Cabin Quilts

The half log cabin book has you do one light strip to one dark strip per block.
(FYI it does not take the whole strip, but easier to figure out yardage.)

In the main part of the book its 2" X WOF strips for the blocks and it makes a 6" finished..
On page 16 is a bonus chart for bigger blocks and if you want to use jelly rolls 2.5" strips or Honey buns 1.5" strips..

*****The very first thing you need to do:**

What size of strip ? 1.5" or 2" or 2.5" strips??

What size block do you want to make??

How big do you want your quilt??

After you figure out that then you can go shopping for fabric...this is a great scrappy quilt pattern too...

Example 2.5" strips, 10" block, making 49 blocks

Quilt will be 7 across by 7 down; 70" x 70"

50- 2.5" strips dark (35" of the 42" used)

50- 2.5" strips Light 3.5 Yards (I did one color,24" used)

Once you got your block size, the amount of blocks you are going to make and your fabric picked out.

It's time to cut it all up for class.

Its nice to make yourself a cheat sheet so you can keep track of all the sizes youo need to cut up and make sure your cut a few extra for each size, so you can play with colors.

****I like to **not** cut up all the 1.5" or 2" or 2.5" pieces; I like to strip a dark strip and a light strip then cut to the size I need. (on the example above I did 3 strip sets and then cut up into 2.5" logs)

HALF LOG CABIN QUILTS

2.5" x WOF STRIPS

8" finished block (8.5" unfinished)

| | Size | Light strips | Dark strips | Blocks |
|-------|-------|----------------|-------------|-----------|
| Lap | 64x72 | 2.25 yds-30 | 3 yds-42 | 8x9=72 |
| Twin | 72x88 | 3 yds-40 | 4 yds-57 | 9x11=99 |
| Full | 88x96 | 4 yds-53 | 5.5yds-75 | 11x12=132 |
| Queen | 96x96 | 4 yds-57 | 6 yds-81 | 12x12=144 |

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

For each size there are lots of strips.

For the 2.5x2.5 squares

I like to sew WOF strips then cut into 2.5" pieces

Sew these sets for the following sizes of quilts

Lap- 5 sets; Twin-7 sets; Full-9 sets; Queen-9 sets

*take one light strip and one dark strip, sew them WOF. To make sets for the first step in your log cabin

- cut 72-lap, 99-twin, 132-full, 144-queen

After you have done that then you can cut out the rest of your 2.5"x WOF strips

Look at above for the amount of blocks you are making

Light strips 4.5" & 6.5"

Dark strips 4.5" & 6.5" & 8.5"

Example:

Lap light strips 72-2.5x4.5" & 72-2.5x6.5"

Dark strips 72-2.5x4.5" & 72-2.5x6.5" &
72-2.5x8.5"
